Community Consultation on Sites



Ingoldisthorpe Parish Council is currently leading on the preparation of a Neighbourhood Plan. The Neighbourhood Plan Working Group, on behalf of the Parish Council, put out a call for sites to consider land that could be available to allocate within the Neighbourhood Plan. This took place between September- October 2024.

The reason this was done was because in the initial consultation with the community in April 2024 a significant number of respondents supported making an allocation in the plan for where new housing should be built. There was not strong consensus on the location but there was consensus that future developments should be small scale, 2 or 3 beds and for local people. Since some of the community in the consultation were supportive of making an allocation, it was considered to be a good opportunity at this stage in the process to explore the idea further.

The site assessment is now available to read on the Ingoldisthorpe Parish Council's website and we wish to hear the communities views on the land put forward for potential new housing allocation in the parish. The community survey where we want your views is running between Monday 3rd February until Friday 28th February 2025. Please find an online copy available when scanning the QR code below.
